Latest EPA Act 2005 Section 701 Waivers Now Available on the AFDC and TransAtlas Web Sites

To facilitate public consumption and analysis of waived alternative fuel vehicle data, the locations of the most recent Energy Policy Act (EPA Act) of 2005 Section 701 waived vehicles are now posted online. The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Alternative Fuels and Advanced Vehicles Data Center (AFDC) offers tabular data based on waiver approvals for 2011 (submitted in June 2010). Data can be downloaded from www.afdc.energy.gov/afdc/data/fleets.html, saved, and analyzed for individual research.

In addition to tabular data, waiver data can also be viewed in TransAtlas, an interactive map that users can customize to display, query, download, and print underlying data. Additional data fields in this tool include:

- Existing and planned alternative fueling stations
- Alternative fuel production facilities
- Light-duty vehicle density among the general public
- Roads and political boundaries.

TransAtlas is part of a suite of geographic analysis tools for renewable energy developed at the National Renewable Energy Laboratory (NREL) and can be found at <http://maps.nrel.gov/transatlas>.

FAST Data Call Closes December 15, 2010

The Federal Automotive Statistical Tool (FAST) fiscal year (FY) 2010 data call will close on Wednesday, December 15, 2010. There are no plans for extending that date or re-opening the FAST FY 2010 data call. This means that by midnight on December 15, your agency's data entry, review, approval, and validation for the FAST portions of the data call must be complete.

As is the case every year, each agency is expected to provide user support and "help desk" resources for any users supporting their agency's submittal and review of the required data. This is particularly important during this final push to complete the data call. Transportation Rotation at FEMP
